**STORY REVIEW (10)** Write a **three or four** paragraph review of the book, using good paragraphing techniques. A person should be able to read your summary and have a good understanding of what the book is about.

**You should make mention somewhere in your review of what significance the title of the book has to the story.**

**COVER PAGE (1)** The neatly organized cover page must include the book's title. Your name and the due date should be on the bottom right hand corner. You may add whatever else you want, but it must relate to the book.

**CHRISTIAN PERSPECTIVE W** Write a paragraph about your reaction to this book as a Christian. If the book was written from a Christian perspective, do you think the characters dealt with conflict in a Godly way? If it was not written from a Christian perspective, how could the characters have dealt with the conflict in a more Christ-like fashion? Give this paragraph some thought. There is no right or wrong answer, and full marks will be given for a well thought out paragraph.

**COMPOSITION (10)** Proper grammar, spelling, sentence structure, and paragraphing must be followed in these reviews. When typing reports, be sure that they are double spaced, using standard 12 pt. type. This will become part of your composition mark.
